A 15 year old Female spayed Maltese presented with chronic superficial pyoderma affecting ventral thorax and abdomen. The dog has been severely itchy and non-responsive to Lokivetmab, an anti-IL31 monoclonal antibody used to treat pruritus in canine atopic patients.

The skin lesions consisted of erythematous multifocal to coalescing papules and crusts. Skin cytology revealed cocci-type bacteria; all signs suggestive of superficial staphylococcal pyoderma.

The patient was treated with topical application of Maxi-Wash spray once daily and Forteclenz Pro shampoo twice weekly (no systemic antibiotics were given).

All skin lesions resolved within 18 days.
